There are many traditional ways in which donors support the needs of residents and staff at communities, but Mr. and Mrs. Kuen Eng expressed their generosity in a different and unique way. The Engs, residents at Ware Presbyterian Village's Vista Ridge, started a scholarship to encourage staff to pursue their dreams of higher education in 2015. The Engs met with PSL's Area Director of Resource Development to develop the scholarship's guidelines and application form. Today, the scholarship is available to all hourly staff at Ware in good standing and who want to pursue any form of higher education.

This fund assists employees with educational expenses such as workshops, tuition, certification or re-certification, and technical skills as well as classes taken in pursuit of any higher degree of learning such as an Associates or Bachelor's degree.

When asked why they decided to start the scholarship, the Engs explained they wanted to give something back to their new home and the community that has embraced them so warmly. "Investing in the future of the staff here is worth every dollar. Staff, especially high school graduates, often could use a helping hand to kick start their education in either college or a trade school. Education is the most valuable tool that someone can have, and we felt that since we have the means, we should help to provide opportunities for the staff that serves us so faithfully."

A recent example of how this scholarship has benefited not only an individual but also the community as a whole is the 2018 recipient, the community's fitness director, Victoria Kates.

The Eng Scholarship provided her with an opportunity to continue her education and obtain her certification with the International Council on Active Aging Leadership in Wellness Management. In turn, this increased Victoria's ability to meet the needs of the residents through wellness in aging and allowed her to grow in her role as a staff member.



Jerry Prosser

Jerry Prosser has been a maintenance staff member at Presbyterian Village at Hollidaysburg (PVH) for forty years. During his time working at PVH, Jerry has had the opportunity to get to know many of the residents beyond being a passerby in the day.

Jerry started playing guitar 12 years ago when his son left his guitar at home after moving away. He picked it up and began to teach himself the basics. After he began to expand his skills, he invested in a nice acoustic guitar of his own. When Jerry started playing the guitar, it was simply for fun; he was not thinking about the profound impact that music can have for people.

While Jerry worked, he would often hum and sing songs. He slowly began to notice that when he sang a tune, the health center residents brightened up and engaged. At this time, Jerry decided to take his guitar skills to the public for the first time and expanded his role from staff member to volunteer.

“Jammin’ Jerry” performs for residents two times per month and covers roughly 10 to 15 songs at each visit. “Some of the most successful songs I play are songs from Hank Williams and Johnny Cash, and songs such as ‘You Are My Sunshine,’ ‘Hey Good Lookin’,’ ‘Ring of Fire,’ and ‘Somewhere Over the Rainbow.’”

Jerry says that his time as a volunteer has been a growing and learning experience for not only the residents but also for himself. “It’s different for me when I perform for the residents because I know all of them. It’s an additional level of connection. At the end of the day, I know I’ve succeeded when I see residents singing along, humming or whistling to the tunes.”

In her five year tenure, Heather Kennedy, the Community Life Director of Glen Meadows Retirement Community, has coordinated many volunteers to come to the community to provide support to the residents. Some of the most unique volunteers arrive at the community on four legs, like Jesse, a Sheltie dog who, along with her owner Sandy, is always ready to brighten a resident’s day.

Glen Meadows has a long-standing relationship with Pets on Wheels, a non-profit organization based in Maryland that focuses on using pets as a therapy to all different types of facilities including hospitals, assisted living facilities, homeless and domestic violence shelters, libraries, schools and more.

Heather says, “You don’t need to have a lot of cognitive skills to enjoy having a dog put its chin in your hand. Sometimes visitors don’t know what to say to a person with dementia or Alzheimer’s, but these visits bring a special compassion and kindness that only a dog can provide.”

Typically, the health center will have around ten different dogs and volunteers come to visit each month. Sandy faithfully brings Jesse every single week. Jesse loves to put his paws up on the sides of residents’ wheelchairs, which they love.

Sandy reflects as her time as a volunteer at Glen Meadows:

“My Sheltie, Jesse and I have been volunteering at Glen Meadows for a little over six years. After I retired, I wanted to give back to the community in some way and Pets on Wheels seemed the perfect fit. As it turned out, Jesse was made for this work and he does it well.

I have to say that this has been a very meaningful experience for me as well as having observed the benefits to the residents we have visited. One of the staff once told me that after a visit from “the dog”, some of the residents have a smile on their faces for the rest of the day. A particular experience that has stayed with me is when a resident stopped me one day on my way out to tell me how much she enjoyed our visits and how much they meant to herself and others there. That touched my heart so deeply that she would take the time to tell me that, I was moved to tears.

There are many other incidents of kindness and gratitude I could relate during our years at Glen Meadows. I wish I could share them all. With few exceptions, the residents have welcomed us and made us feel a part of their lives and almost always our visits end with a thank you. I’d say this is a two-way street; it helps others and also feeds my soul (and Jesse’s.) We have experienced grace in action.”

The commitment of the Pets on Wheels volunteers has allowed residents to connect and interact with the community in new ways. The smiles that this program puts on the residents’ faces are priceless.

“Enthusiastic third graders arrive at our campus filled with energy and excitement that brings joy to the residents at Windy Hill Village (WHV).” Isaac Solak, the Community Life Director of WHV, has been facilitating a unique connection between residents at the community and local elementary school students since September of 2018.

The program with Philipsburg Elementary School blossomed with an idea from a teacher, who reached out to WHV with a proposal to begin a partnership between third-grade students and the residents.

After investigating the potential benefits for both parties, the senior community and the elementary school established a beautiful partnership.

Every Friday at 1 p.m. a group of third graders takes a short walk from their school campus to the multipurpose room of WHV to practice their reading skills with the residents. The teachers of the elementary school tie in their lesson plans and leverage this opportunity to enhance their curriculum in a practical way. Sometimes the students will read books to the residents or even a poem they have written themselves. The residents will also often write poems for the students to read to practice something new.

The concept of intergenerational programs is not uncommon, as these programs are incredibly beneficial to both parties. These programs help to teach lessons of empathy, intergenerational collaboration, and a spirit of volunteerism in the lives of children and are designed to encourage participants to hold onto these attributes as they grow. The teachers of Philipsburg Elementary School strive to instill in each child that each of us has time and talents, and we should share them.

Seniors are naturally drawn to children; often residents who are not interested in interacting with anyone at all will light up around children. At WHV, the residents are always anxiously awaiting their next session together.

PARTNERSHIP OPTIONS

Cash

You can easily make a gift by check, credit card or cash. It's easy to make an immediate or recurring gift using our website, www.psl.org.

Bequests

It's easy to designate PSL as a partial beneficiary of your will or living trust. You can specify a fixed amount, a percentage of your estate, or the residual value after other gifts have been made. There are many options, talk to your attorney about this in more detail.

Appreciated Securities

Gifts of appreciated securities made directly from your account to PSL can help you save taxes on capital gains and get an immediate income tax deduction for the full value of the gift.

Charitable Gift Annuities (CGA)

In return for a gift of cash or appreciated securities in a CGA contract, PSL will pay you a fixed income for your life. You receive an immediate, partial income tax deduction and lifetime income, a portion of which may not be taxable.

Partners in Mission

Businesses can become a Partner in Mission by making a gift to a special event or a specific community. This group of major donors can make a single contribution that will benefit multiple needs throughout the organization.

IRA Beneficiary

The IRA Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD)
