


Welcome to Presbyterian Village

At Presbyterian Village at Hollidaysburg, you can expect maintenance-free living and a supportive community of new friends,





INDEPENDENT LIVING RESIDENCY INVESTMENT FEES

(Effective January 1, 2024 - subject to change without notice)

Our Fee Structure

For both singles and couples at Presbyterian Village, a one-time **Residency Investment Fee**, plus a reasonable **Monthly Maintenance Fee** – based on the type of apartment or cottage you choose – provides you with living accommodations that fit your lifestyle. Many of the residents find that living at Presbyterian Village is more convenient and less costly than living in their own homes. The Residency Investment Fee is often covered by the sale of a house. The Monthly Fee is usually covered by Social Security, pensions and/or money used for monthly utility bills and home maintenance/repair, transportation, insurance premiums and property taxes.

Residency Investment Fee

We offer you a choice of two entrance plans. Both entitle you to a life-lease of your living unit, (i.e., the right to reside in the community for the rest of your life under the terms of the Residence and Care Agreement).

- Our **50 Month Plan** assures residents that if they should withdraw from the community within the first 50 months, they will receive a partial refund based on a 2% reduction of their Residency Investment Fee for every month of occupancy. After 50 months of occupancy there is no refund under this plan.
- Our **50% Refund Plan** has a slightly higher Residency Investment Fee but provides (after 25 months) for a 50% minimum refund based on a 2% reduction of the Residency Investment Fee for every month of occupancy.
