Our Rental Plan

The market rental rates at The Long Community – based on the type of apartment you choose – provide you with living accommodations that fit your lifestyle. Many of the residents find that living at The Long Community is more convenient and less costly than living in their own homes.

We offer a one year lease, and after one year of residency, you can be released of your apartment with a 60 day notice. With our “no entrance fee approach” we offer a program that will not tie down a portion of your savings or your time.
