PSL works with families and residents to create individualized care plans when the end of life is imminent. The goal is to honor the remainder of your time on this earth. We work with you to minimize pain and symptoms and improve comfort not only physically but emotionally, socially, intellectually and spiritually for you and your support system. At times, this care may be supplemented with hospice services from an outside agency cooperatively supporting the individual with the PSL team and family.

Ware Presbyterian Village offers End of Life Care where you can exercise your independence while receiving the assistance needed. In addition to striving for the highest standards of physical support services, we provide socially stimulating activities as well as 24-hour supervision of medical needs by the nursing team.

Veterans and surviving spouses who require End of Life Care may be eligible for assistance from the Veterans Administration. Ware Presbyterian Village offers assistance with obtaining these benefits should you qualify for them. Some long-term care insurance policies may also pay for End of Life Care.
